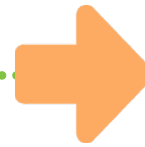
1. EMS Dispatched

You are dispatched to a CPR in progress, DOA, or any other life-ending event.



2. Death is Pronounced

Unfortunately, death has occurred and the patient has been pronounced.



3. Make the Call

Open the camera app on your phone and scan the QR code. This will connect you directly to HonorBridge's Donor Service Center. Save the contact for future use!



6. Key Information

- Your Contact
- Patient Demographics
- Time & Circumstances of Death
- Medical Interventions
- Known Medical History
- Medical Examiner Status
- Body Transport Location
- Next of Kin Contact



5. HIPPA Compliance

Federal Regulation 45 CFR 164.512 allows you to share patient information with Organ Procurement Organizations for evaluation of tissue and eye donation.



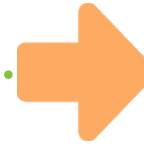
4. During the Call

An HonorBridge Coordinator will request key information from the EMS provider to determine eye and tissue suitability.



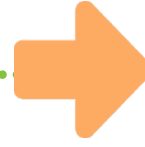
7. Leave a Legacy

By referring scene deaths to HonorBridge, you are giving North Carolinians the opportunity to leave a legacy through the gift of tissue and eye donation.



8. Save & Heal Lives

Similar to organ transplantation, tissue can also be recovered for transplantation. Tissue from ONE donor can save and heal more than 75 recipients.
