


Transplantable Organs and Their Benefits



Donated Organ	Those who will Benefit
Heart	Patients suffering from cardiomyopathy, coronary artery disease, or other life-threatening heart diseases.
Lungs	Patients suffering from emphysema, cystic fibrosis, or other life-threatening lung diseases.
Liver	Patients suffering from cirrhosis, Wilson's disease, or other life-threatening liver diseases.
Pancreas	Insulin-dependent diabetic patients (a transplant eliminates the need for insulin injections and reduces the risk of losing their sight or limbs.
Kidneys	Patients suffering from severe kidney failure caused by conditions such as high blood pressure or polycystic kidney disease (a transplant eliminates the need for dialysis).
Small Intestine	Patients are generally children who suffer from short bowel syndrome or intestinal malformation.
